item ND. 6: Emergency services reports	Jeff Christiansen of Milford Fire Dept. reported that there have been 415 Fire and 587 EMS calls this year-to-date. Their ambulance is still out of service but should be completed in January. In the meantime they have borrowed DTVFD's second ambulance. Training is on-going.
item ND. 7: Rdadmaster Report	Roadmaster Jim Snyder reported that they again had to plow PaDOT roads in order to get to our roads during the storm last week. They even received a couple requests to plow via the Comm Center. Chairman Mincer stated that this scenario is getting quite old where PaDOT drops the ball and we wind up having to plow state roads. MOTION was made by Ed Nikles, seconded by Dennis Brink, and unanimously carried to approve the November 5-18, 2018 Roadmaster Report as submitted and presented.
ITEM ND. 8: Sewage / Zoning Officer Report	Chris Wood reported that he attended a meeting FEMA held to discuss the new floodplain maps for Pike County that should be sent out for review in Spring 2019. The improved imaging should reduce the elevation error to +/- six inches.
