ITEM NO. 1: CALL TO ORDER	Chairman Mincer called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm opening with the Pledge of Allegiance.
ITEM NO. 2: APPROVAL OF MINUTES	MOTION was made by Dennis Brink, seconded by Ed Nikles, and unanimously carried to approve the March 19, 2019 Minutes as presented.
ITEM ND. 3: PUBLIC HEARINGS A) Preserve at Milford Hills	This Item was tabled until later in the meeting after Solicitor Klemeyer arrived.
	Solicitor Klemeyer informed the Board that the latest draft of the Developers Agreement is acceptable. He relayed that the Developer stated that they cannot get a bond commitment without a signed Agreement. MOTION was made by Ed Nikles, seconded by Dennis Brink, and unanimously carried to continue the Hearing to May 7, 2019 and to authorize the signing of the Developers Agreement outside a meeting.
ITEM NO 4: OLD BUSNIEES A) PennDOT re: Tunnel Road	Jennifer Borino, PennDot District 4-0 Project Manager and Ed Jones of L.R. Kimball were present to discuss improvements planned for the tunnel on Tunnel Road during that phase of reconstruction on 184. They will be widening it to 16' wide and raising it to 14'6" high and will be adding a cul-de-sac on the far side where the road ends. Construction will be starting on 184 in 2020.
ITEM ND. 4(B): Budget Amendment: Res. No. 2019-04	Karen Kleist confirmed that the proposed amendment satisfies both requirements in the MPC. 2019 Ending Balance Funds are being allocated to expense accounts to cover a replacement tractor for the park and for a new roof and misc. items at the Grange building. MOTION was made by Ed Nikles, seconded by Dennis Brink, and unanimously carried to adopt Resolution No. 2019-04, Budget Amendment.

ITEM ND. 5: NEW BUSINESS A) 2018 Audit Report	The Board reviewed the FY2D18 Audit prepared by Kirk Summa & Co. There were no findings or recommendations. MOTION was made by Dennis Brink, seconded by Ed Nikles, and unanimously carried to accept the 2018 Audit Report.

ITEM NO. 6: CORRESPONDENCE A) Country Estates at Mt. Haven POA	This Item was tabled until the arrival of Solicitor Klemeyer,
	The Board was in receipt of a letter from the POA informing that a Court Order was issued October 17, 2017 that Har Haven would remove the fencing obstructions in the travelway of Mt. Haven Drive and requesting the Township enforce it's guidelines regarding the same. Solicitor Klemeyer previously responded that the Township cannot enforce a Court Orders. Thomas Mincer and Ed Nikles have potential conflicts on this matter.
ITEM ND. 6(B): Kiely Service Co. re: Sawkill Gas Main Replacement	The Board received notification that UGI Utilities has made application to PaDEP to replace their gas main crossing the Sawkill at Wykoff Lane (main is suspended under bridge). The Board directed the Secretary to send a letter requesting UGI give advanced noticed of the construction schedule to the residents that utilize the bridge.
