

Registration of Political Signs

As required by § 515 of the
Dingman Township Zoning Ordinance

Instructions

Person Registering Signs:

Should be a person with local authority involved in the campaign.

Nature of Signs:

Check as appropriate.

Candidate Signs: Are signs relating to a particular candidate for political office for example: Smith for Congress

Issue Signs: Are signs relating to an issue to be voted on. For example: Vote No on Proposition #1 –or- Vote Yes for mandatory recycling.

Candidate to be promoted:

If applicable, list all candidates for which your organization will be placing signs. For example:

John Smith for Congress
John Johnson for State Representative

Issues to be promoted:

If applicable, list issues in which you will be placing signs. Be sure to state which side of issue you are promoting. For example:

No on Proposition #1
Yes on mandatory recycling

Regulations:

Read and sign as indicated. List organization you are representing.
For Example:

John J. Johnson
Citizens for Smith

- or -

John Q. Public
Coalition for Mandatory Recycling

Optional:

It is your responsibility to remove the signs in a timely manner. However, occasionally a few signs are missed. Signing here would allow Dingman Township employees to remove missed signs (at the Township's discretion) instead of notifying you.

Issues to be promoted:

Regulations:

1. No political sign may be displayed for more than 180 days.
2. No political sign may be displayed for more than 21 days following the election in which they are applicable.
3. No political sign may be placed closer than five (5) feet to the curb line or edge of road pavement.
4. No political signs may be placed in a location where it would create a traffic hazard.
5. No political sign may exceed 32 square feet in size.
6. There may not be more than two (2) political signs for any candidate/issue on any one property.

I have read the above regulations and promise to abide by them. I furthermore acknowledge that I will promptly remove any signs in violation of the above.
