

TRAIL CONSTRUCTION GUIDELINES AND GENERAL NOTES

ECOSYSTEMS. THERE SHOULD BE NO LONG-TERM IMPACT ON WILDLIFE.
REMOVAL OF SOME PLANTS MY BE REQUIRED. PLACE CUT BRANCHES AND TREES MINIMUM 10 FEET FROM TRAIL EDGE. WOODY PLANTS 2" CALIPER OR LESS SHOULD BE MINIMUM TO FEET FROM TRAIL EDGE. WOUDT FLANTS 2 CALIFER OR LESS SHOULD BE COMPLETELY REMOVED FROM THE TRAIL TREAD, INCLUDING ROOTS LARGER THAN THE DIAMETER OF A PENCIL. LARGER CALIPER TREES SHOULD REMAIN AND THE TRAILTREAD WILL MANEUVER AROUND THESE TREES.

TRAIL SHOULD BLEND WITH THE LAND AND FOLLOW CONTOURS WHERE POSSIBLE. AVOID

IRAIL SHOULD BLEND WITH THE LAND AND FOLLOW CONTOURS WHERE FOSSIBLE. AVOID STRAIGHT LINES.
WHEN CUTTING THE TRAIL TREAD INTO THE SLOPE, COMPLETE A FULL BENCH CUT. CRIB WALLS IF NEEDED ON DOWNSLOPE SHOULD BE CONSTRUCTED WITH ANGULAR ROCKS, AVOID ROUNDED ROCKS SINCE THEY CAN ROLL.
ENCOURAGE SHEET FLOW DRAINAGE. CONSTRUCT TRAILS WITH A CROSSLOPE OF 1-2% TO PROMOTE SHEET FLOW DRAINAGE AND REDUCE TRAIL EROSION BY WATER. USE ROLLING GRADE DIPS TO PROMOTE DRAINAGE IN WET AREAS, AVOID WATER BARS.

• LOOK FOR A NATURAL ROLL OR EXISTING CHANGE IN GRADE TO IMPLEMENT GRADE

REVERSALS. GRADE REVERSALS (GRADE DIPS, KNICKS, GRADE BREAKS) SHOULD BE BUILT INTO TRAIL APPROX. EVERY 50 FEET.

PRUNING SHALL CONFORM TO THE ANSI—A300—1995 PRUNING STANDARDS — "TREE, SHRUBS, AND OTHER WOODY PLANT MAINTENANCE — STANDARD PRACTICES." THE ANSI STANDARDS ARE MADE PART OF THIS CONTRACT BY THIS REFERENCE. DO NOT CAUSE BARK DAMAGE TO STANDING TIMBER. TREAT INJURED TREES IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD SET FORTH IN ANSI—A30—1995.

----- MULCH 4" DEPTH — GEOTEXTILE FABRIC - ASPHALT MILLINGS * SEE NOTES (DEPTH VARIES BASED ON SURFACE ROCK)

—UNDISTURBED SUBGRADE 1. ASPHALT MILLINGS NEEDED ONLY IN LOCALIZED AREAS OF HIGH SURFACE ROCKS TO PROVIDE LEVEL BASE, OR CONTRACTOR CAN REMOVE ROCK. (ANY MILLINGS WILL BE PROVIDED BY DINGMAN TOWNSHIP, UPON REQUEST). 2. SURFACE ROCKS SHOULD NOT BE LOCATED WITHIN 4" OF SURFACE OF FINAL TRAIL TREAD. 3. 


